Special Neptune Program at Ingram Planetarium

Celebrate the anniversary of the planet Neptune's discovery on Saturday, September 24, 2011 from 7:00 to 8:30 PM. See a star show in the Planetarium's Sky Theater at 7:00 PM, then go outside (weather permitting) for an evening of telescope viewing. Dr. Barry Kirkham, former assistant operations scientist and senior Hubble systems engineer at Goddard Space Flight Center, will be on hand to discuss the greatest telescope of all, the Hubble Space Telescope, and how it helped to unlock the secrets of Neptune.
